The model is a reflection tool. The model is applied to concrete actions and situations in practice.

You can use it individually, or in groups. You can use it to construct a reflection dialog, or you can use it in a written reflection.

The model gives you the possibility to, in a systematic way, to discover new perspectives of your actions in practice, it enables you to find other and maybe more efficient way to act, and it trains your ability to argue for your actions and choices.

The model consists of some guiding questions.





## THE FUTURE PERSPECTIVE

- \* Have I learned something new?
- \* How can I use this new knowledge in a similar situation?
- \* Is there something we have to do, or consider befor it is possible for me to use the new knowledge?

\*Is there something we sholud develop, fokus on, or test in order to make it possible to do things different? Who shall do it? When? and How?



## **ACTION/SITUATION**

- \* Describe the situation and the persons involved.
- \* Which elements in the situation do you want to focus on, or do you find interesting/puzzling?



# PRACTICE REFLECTION



### **ABSTRACTION**

- \* Could I have done otherwise? were there other options?
- \* If so, what would/could be the consequences?
- \* Which conclusions can I draw?
  - \* What was succesfull in the situation, and why?



## REFLECTION

- \* Which elements/factors had an influence or impact on your perception of the situation?den blev?
- \*What did i do? Why did i do that?
  - \* Did I achieve what i had planned/my goal?
- \* Did knowledge, experience, therory or other factors influence my decisions and actions?
